

## Instructions for registering a QR code – Registration for 2FA

All users with elevated permissions need 2FA (two-factor authentication) to access Dir X Web Center. Registration for 2FA is therefore only possible for users with the appropriate credentials and permissions, and it should be carried out as follows:

1. Install the Google Authenticator mobile application from the Apple Store, Google Play Store or Microsoft Store on your mobile. The icon of this application is shown in the figure below.



2. Then open the following link in the web browser on your computer or laptop:

**Important: Mozilla Firefox cannot be used for this purpose as it does not function correctly**

3. Enter your **ETH user name** and **ETH password for web applications, AAI (LDAP)** on the following screen and click "Login"

5. Open Google Authenticator on the smartphone and select the option "Scan barcode". You will receive a PIN (OTP – One Time Password).
- 6. Close the browser**
7. To log in to Web Center, please enter the following link on your computer or laptop [www.password.ethz.ch](http://www.password.ethz.ch).
8. Only after entering your ETH user name and ETH password for web applications, AAI (LDAP) will the OTP (PIN), which you received from the "Google Authenticator" app, be requested. After entering this PIN you will be able to access Web Center.
